The RTC Transit System is experiencing a severe drop in funding as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. To adjust for this loss in revenue, the RTC is considering making system-wide service changes in Fall 2020. Proposed changes include route eliminations, routing adjustments and schedule changes.

PROPOSED CHANGES

Proposed route **eliminations**:

- 207, 209, SDX, WAX

Proposed **routing adjustments**:

- 104, CX, Deuce, HDX, SX

Proposed **frequency decrease**:

- 122

HDX

Henderson & Downtown Express

- The HDX will be shortened to run only between Water Street and Boulder City. It will no longer run to Downtown Las Vegas or the Sunset & Stephanie area.
- The route may run a little more frequently, possibly every 40-50 minutes.
- The route will stay on I-11, bypassing Nevada State College (NSC). NSC area will continue being serviced by the BHX-B.
- The Paratransit service area will be reduced by 0.27 miles. There are currently nine paratransit customers in that area, who will all be grandfathered into the service.

-  HDX eliminated from BTC to Water St. & from NSC
-  HDX service maintained from Boulder City to Water St., excluding NSC
-  Deleted from Paratransit Service Area (0.27 Sq Miles)
-  Current Paratransit Service Area (341 Sq Miles)
