<u>Note</u>: This document does not contain all proposed bus stop level changes along existing route paths, such as the addition of a stop or relocation/deletion of a bus stop without a physical routing change.

Route 101 - Rainbow:

• Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.

Route 102 – Jones:

No changes.

Route 103 – Decatur:

• Implement new schedules to make service more reliable in anticipation of a major upcoming road construction project along the route.

Route 104 – Valley View:

• No changes.

Route 105 – Martin L. King:

No changes.

Route 106 – Rancho / Centennial Hills:

• No changes.



Route 108 – Paradise:

• No changes.

Route 109 – Maryland Pkwy:

• Modify schedules to maximize reliability & timeliness of service.

Route 110 - Eastern:

• Implement new schedules to make service more reliable due to traffic delays associated with construction projects.

Route 111 – Pecos/Green Valley Pkwy: *Routing & Bus Stop Changes*

- Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.
- Return to directly serving the CSN Cheyenne campus on most NB weekday trips.

Route 113 -N. Las Vegas Blvd.:

• No changes.

Route 115 – Nellis / Stephanie:

• Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.

Route 117 –S. Las Vegas Blvd. / Silverado Ranch:

• No changes.

Route 119 – Simmons / Koval:

• Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.

Route 120 – Fort Apache / Rampart:

• Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.

Route 121 – Durango / Buffalo:

- Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.
 - This will result in increasing frequency to every 30 minutes (currently once an hour) during Weekday daytime hours, making service more convenient for customers.

Route 122 -S. Maryland Pkwy / W. Henderson:

• No changes.

Route 201 – Tropicana:

• Implement new schedules to make service more reliable in anticipation of a major upcoming road construction project along the route.

Route 202 – Flamingo: *Routing & Bus Stop Changes*

- Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.
- Reverse west end loop for all trips to improve intersection safety at Grand Canyon & Rochelle. The exact routing will be as follows:



- From WB Flamingo, continue west on Flamingo, south on Grand Canyon & layover just after Rochelle. EB trips will start from this location by continuing south on Grand Canyon, east on Peace, north on Fort Apache, east on Flamingo, and resume the current routing.
 - New bus stops will be established along the reversed loop, approximately near current bus stops (which will close, except along Fort Apache) on the opposite side of the street.

Route 203 - Spring Mtn / Desert Inn / Lamb:

• Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.

Route 206 – Charleston:

- Implement new schedules to make service more reliable due to traffic delays associated with construction projects.
 - o East end layover for two trips between 6:30 a.m. & 7:00 a.m. will be relocated to NB Sloan after Sahara.

Route 207 – Alta / Stewart:

- Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.
 - Service will now start approximately one hour earlier on Weekdays (earlier first trip added in each direction).

Route 208 – Washington:

• Implement minor schedule changes on a small number of trips & in specific locations.

Route 209 – Vegas / Owens:

- Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.
 - Service will now start approximately 40 to 45 minutes earlier on Weekdays (earlier first trip added in each direction).

Route 210 – Lake Mead Blvd:

- Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.
 - East end layover for two trips between approximately 12:55 p.m. & 1:35 p.m. will be relocated to NB Hollywood after Lake Mead, before the east end loop.

Route 212 – Sunset:

• Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.

Route 214 –H Street / D Street:

• No changes.

Route 215 -Bonanza:

• No changes.

Route 217 - Warm Springs / Lake Mead Pkwy: *Routing & Bus Stop Changes*



- Adopt the current detour in the Silverton area as permanent routing; exact routing is as follows:
 - From SB Dean Martin, buses will travel west on Blue Diamond, south on Valley View, east on Shelbourne alignment (first left turn opportunity), north on Dean Martin, and resume current routing beginning at Bus Stop ID 6327, which will be unaffected.
 - Bus Stop ID 6642 on Silverton property (near Cracker Barrel) will be permanently eliminated. Bus Stop ID 6327 will continue to be available for Silverton customers.

Route 218 – Cheyenne:

- Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.
 - This will result in increasing frequency slightly (from once an hour currently to approximately every 45-50 minutes) during some evening hours (seven days a week) & Sunday morning hours, making service more convenient for customers.

Route 219 – Craig:

- Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.
- Add one additional partial trip on Weekdays WB during the 6 a.m. hour & EB during the 1 p.m. hour, to provide necessary capacity due to high ridership from CCSD students.

Route 220 -Ann / Tropical:

- Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.
 - EB service east of Decatur will now start approximately one hour earlier, seven days a week (earlier partial first trip added).
 - WB service between Hollywood & Lamb at Nexus will now start approximately one hour earlier, seven days a week (earlier trip added in this area).
- Move WB time point K to the new bus stop on WB El Campo Grande west of Sloan; bus stop ID 6975 on SB Sloan after Tropical will remain available but will relocate closer to Tropical & will no longer be a time point.

Route 221 - Cactus / Horizon Ridge / Boulder City:

• No changes.

Deuce on the Strip:

• Provide additional capacity, to the extent shown necessary by the latest ridership data.

Route 401 –N. Outlets / Symphony Park:

- Start service earlier in the morning, and end service later in the evening, to match the current regular (non-seasonal) hours of the LV North Premium Outlets.
 - O Current regular (non-seasonal) Outlet hours are 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. Mon.-Thurs.; 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. Fri. & Sat.; and 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Sundays.

BHX –**Boulder Hwy Express:**

• Modify schedules to maximize reliability & timeliness of service.



SX – Sahara Express: *Routing & Bus Stop Changes*

- Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.
- Adopt the current detour at SX-A east end (reversing the previous direction of the loop) as permanent routing due to traffic concerns at Vegas Valley & Tree Line. The exact routing is as follows:
 - o From EB Sahara, continue east on Sahara, south on Hollywood, west on Vegas Valley & layover in turnout just west of Hollywood during most hours. WB trips will start from this location by continuing west on Vegas Valley, north on Tree Line, west on Sahara, and resume the current routing.
 - New bus stops will be established along the reversed loop, approximately near current bus stops (which will close) on the opposite side of the street.
 - Some SX-A trips starting before 8 a.m. & after 10 p.m. daily will instead layover on WB Sahara after Sloan, after completing the loop, rather than at Vegas Valley & Hollywood.

CX -Centennial Express: *Routing & Bus Stop Changes*

- Modify routing to use Flamingo instead of Tropicana to travel between I-15 & Maryland Pkwy, to avoid major construction delays near Tropicana & I-15. CX will now serve bus stops on Flamingo near LVB instead of on Tropicana near LVB. The exact routing will be as follows:
 - o From SB I-15, exit Flamingo East, continue east on Flamingo, south on Maryland Pkwy to UNLV, and resume current routing to Reid Airport.
 - The SB CX will now serve the following bus stops between I-15 & UNLV:
 - ID 957, EB Flamingo after Las Vegas Blvd.
 - ID 6687, EB Flamingo after Linq Lane
 - ID 955, EB Flamingo after Koval
 - ID 1735, SB Maryland Pkwy after Flamingo
 - ID 1730, SB Maryland Pkwy after Cottage Grove
 - Other bus stops along EB Flamingo between Koval & Claymont/Cambridge will not be served by CX.
 - o From NB Maryland Pkwy, continue north on Maryland Pkwy, west on Flamingo, north on I-15, and resume current routing toward Downtown.
 - The NB CX will now serve the following bus stops between UNLV & I-15:
 - ID 1742, NB Maryland Pkwy after Harmon
 - ID 962, WB Flamingo after Maryland
 - ID 956, WB Flamingo after Koval
 - ID 6649, WB Flamingo after Linq Lane
 - ID 958, WB Flamingo after Las Vegas Blvd.
- Reduce bus stops in Downtown to provide faster service for most customers. The
 following bus stops will no longer be served by the CX, but will remain open for other
 routes:
 - o NB:
 - ID 36, NB 4th after Lewis (customers should use Stop ID 6142, after Carson, or BTC instead).



- ID 6203, NB 4th after Stewart (customers should use Stop ID 6142, between Carson & Fremont, instead).
- o SB:
 - ID 6152, SB Casino Center after Stewart (customers should use Stop ID 5461, at Fremont Street, instead).
- Modify schedules to make service more reliable & timely.

DVX – Downtown & Veteran's Medical Center Express:
